Cornwall special reference to Mid-Cornwall’**

Dick Cole is perhaps best known for leading Mebyon Kernow, the party for Cornwall, since 1997. He was elected to serve his home parish of St Ender on Restormel Borough Council in 1999 and, in 2009, stood down from his employment with the Cornwall Archaeological Unit, so that he could stand for election to Cornwall Council. He is The Site Officer for Cornwall Heritage Trust with extensive knowledge of its sites and Cornish archaeology.

Dick is a bard of Gorsedh Kernow – Gwythias an Tir (Guardian of the Land)
